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KITCHEN HAND TOWEL

Save money on expensive paper towels every time you rinse your hands in the kitchen. ; you'll save trees too ,which is a win for the environment.

Size

Hand towel: approx. 35cm X 45cm

Materials

2 balls Heirloom cotton 8ply
1 pair 3.75mm needles

Tension

23sts to 10cm over stocking stitch using 3.75mm needles.

Instructions

Cast on 85 sts.

Row 1: *K1, P1, rep. from * to end of row.
This row sets pattern (moss stitch).

Repeat 1st Row 5 times (6 rows moss stitch in all).

Work 6 rows garter stitch (knit every stitch).

Repeat 1st Row (moss stitch) until work measures 42cm.

Work 6 rows garter stitch.

Work a further 6 rows moss stitch as set.

Cast off in moss stitch.



Hanging Loop (optional)

The loop can be attached to one corner, centred on one end or along the side (as pictured). We made ours from a scrap of tape but you could knit an icord loop on 3 stitches. Some garment labels make excellent, and very stylish, hanging loops. Unpick the labels from garments not suitable for recycling; don't forget to salvage any useful buttons at the same time.
